KYIV SECURITY FORUM The Kyiv Security Forum (KSF) is Ukraine's foremost public platform for high-level discussion on the pressing issues of national, regional and global security matters and international affairs.

Since 2007, when it was established by the Arseniy Yatsenyuk Open Ukraine Foundation, the KSF annually gathers regional and international leaders, senior officials, politicians, diplomats, civic activists and journalists for regular and special assemblies.

MISSION

Ideas of Euro-Atlantic solidarity, strengthening and further enlargement of NATO and the European Union, and Ukraine's and its neighbors' membership in these organizations.

Values and principles of rule-based international order, democratic rights and freedoms, national sovereignty and civilized cooperation against the threats of authoritarianism, political oppression and foreign aggression, as, in particular, Russia's ongoing war against Ukraine and the West.

Practical actions of the security partnership and political, economic, humanitarian and environmental cooperation in Eastern Europe.

FORUMS

Since 2007, there have been fourteen **Kyiv Security Forums** and nine **Kyiv Security Youth Forums**, annually bringing together up to a thousand participants from all over the globe.

SPECIAL FORMATS

In March 2020, the Kyiv Security Forum launched a new popular format – the **KSF Online Discussions**. Since then, the KSF audience has enjoyed the participation of more than 70 internationally recognized speakers in online conversations.

In March 2021, the Kyiv Security Forum presented "Twelve Points of Strategic Partnership Between the United States and Ukraine" – a unique strategic document, co-signed by prominent American and Ukrainian politicians, diplomats and experts.

In September 2021, the Kyiv Security Forum launched an initiative of the youth meetings "West – East, North – South". The first meeting in Lviv gathered more than 100 young activists and professionals from all parts of Ukraine.
